EU Data Act Notice

The Regulation (EU) 2023/2854 (EU Data Act) gives users of connected products and related services the right to be provided with information about data generated by these products and related services, that are subject to the EU Data Act.

- Service providers, acting as processors on our behalf, where necessary in order to perform their services for us (such as our cloud service or system providers); Before entering into a data processing agreement with Leica Geosystems AG, the applicable list of these sub-processors for your product is provided to you together with or as part of the data processing agreement.
- Law enforcement authorities and regulators, attorneys, consultants in connection with complying with our legal obligations or establishing, exercising or defending rights or claims;
- Content published by you on our websites' offering (such as chat rooms or forums) may be globally accessible to other registered users of the respective offering.

Depending on the related service, you will find further information about the related service in the terms of use, that are provided to you before concluding a contract. This can be as part of an invitation to you to

place an order or before clicking an accept button or before you can access, download or use Hexagon Technology or any other form suitable for the product.
